United Way-Thomas Jefferson Area Child Care Scholarship Program Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for assistance, the child's parent(s) or guardian must be a resident of the City of Charlottesville or Albemarle County and be employed or enrolled in an educational program or vocational training program (or a combination of the two equal to full-time). Families must also meet program [income guidelines](#).

Participants provide pay stubs or employment letters to verify their income and hours of work, last year's tax return, driver's license and proof of residency. If you are attending school, you must provide documentation to verify hours. For detailed information on eligibility, please click [here](#).

The amount of each child's scholarship will vary depending on household income, the number of persons in the home, the child's age, and the cost of the child care. In all cases, the family pays a co-payment equal to 10% of their gross monthly income.

The choice of a child care provider, whether a center or a home, is made by the parent(s). However, the provider chosen must be either registered through Children Youth and Family Services (CYFS) or a State Licensed child care provider.
