- 7 am** A mother drops off her child at a licensed day care center on the way to work, thanks to a United Way Child Care Scholarship.
- 9 am** A rural healthcare clinic begins treating low income and uninsured patients.
- 11 am** Low income, disabled seniors enjoy a sing-along at an adult day care facility, while their family members are able to go to work or run errands.
- Noon** Physically and mentally challenged adults are on lunch break from their work at a sheltered workplace, which provides them employment and dignity.
- 3 pm** Local children arrive at an after-school center rather than an empty house while their parents are still at work.
- 5 pm** A counseling session begins for a family with anger management issues, reducing the possibility of abuse.
- 7 pm** A young professional logs on to the United Way Volunteer Center's website, searching for opportunities near his home.
- 10 pm** Individuals without homes have settled into a shelter for an overnight stay.
- 1 am** A troubled teen calls a 24-hour runaway services hotline.
