2. Why were only two clients referred for services (Indicators 3B)?

The correct figure should be 13. The number is low due to the fact that many of our clients are young (20's and 30's) and have good screenings. About 80% of our referrals are due to blood pressure readings outside the normal range.

These screenings are important because they provide several vital statistics to determine the general health of a client as well as an opportunity to provide education and inspiration for maintaining excellent health. We screen for blood pressure (hypertension), blood sugar (diabetes), and cholesterol. For most of our clients we are their only source for obtaining this information. We also see many of them more than once, which gives an opportunity to monitor progress or regression in their health and show them how behavioral changes really can make a difference.

3. Please submit the data for Outcomes 4-6?
