The United Way Student Service Award, a United Way-Thomas Jefferson Area Volunteer Center community initiative, will be presented at the April 12, 2011 Celebration of Youth Service. The United Way Student Service Award is given to one student from each high school in the City of Charlottesville and in Albemarle, Fluvanna, Greene, Louisa and Nelson Counties (public and private) for their exceptional commitment to volunteer service.

## ELIGIBILITY

Nominees must have performed volunteer activities for nonprofit or charitable organizations or other organizations aimed at improving or promoting the general welfare of the community during 2010/11.

Students must be in grades 9-12 and enrolled in a public or private high school in the City of Charlottesville or in Albemarle, Fluvanna, Greene, Louisa or Nelson Counties.

Past award recipients are not eligible.

## NOMINATIONS

Nominations must be submitted on the United Way Student Service Award nomination form. Nomination forms can be found online at [www.UnitedWayTJA.org](http://www.UnitedWayTJA.org).

Nominations will be accepted from citizens, nonprofit organizations, public agencies, schools, and religious organizations. Self-nominations are acceptable; however a non-family member must sign-off on the application.

Nominees should not have received any compensation for their volunteer work, excluding reimbursement for out-of-pocket expenses.

## NOMINATING CRITERIA

Judges will evaluate applications for:

- Creativity and initiative.
- Scope of responsibility and time given.
- Dependability and enthusiasm.
